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Zima Virus Causing International Panic

Film and Media Studies

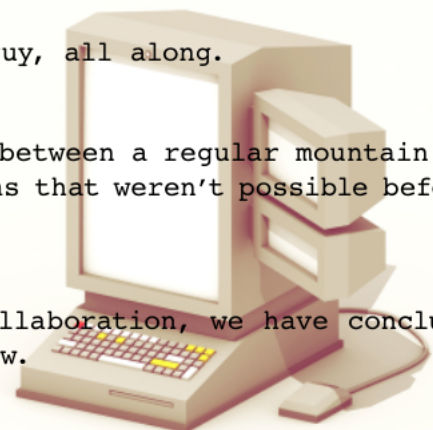
We found out that Tyler Durden and Jack were the same guy, all along.

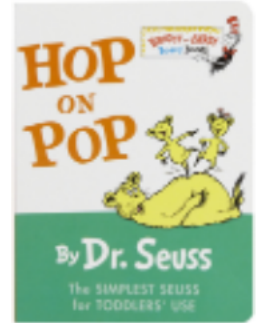

Themes, Motifs & Symbols: Directions, mobility, fashion, systemic prejudice in dog society.

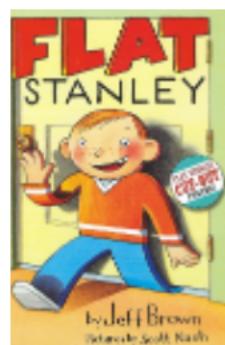
Quote: “Do you like my hat?” said the girl dog. “Fuck off,” said the boy dog.

Themes, Motifs & Symbols: Disillusionment, pain, loneliness, fear

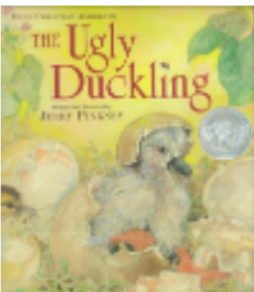
Quote: “Goodnight stars, goodnight air, goodnight sadness and despair”

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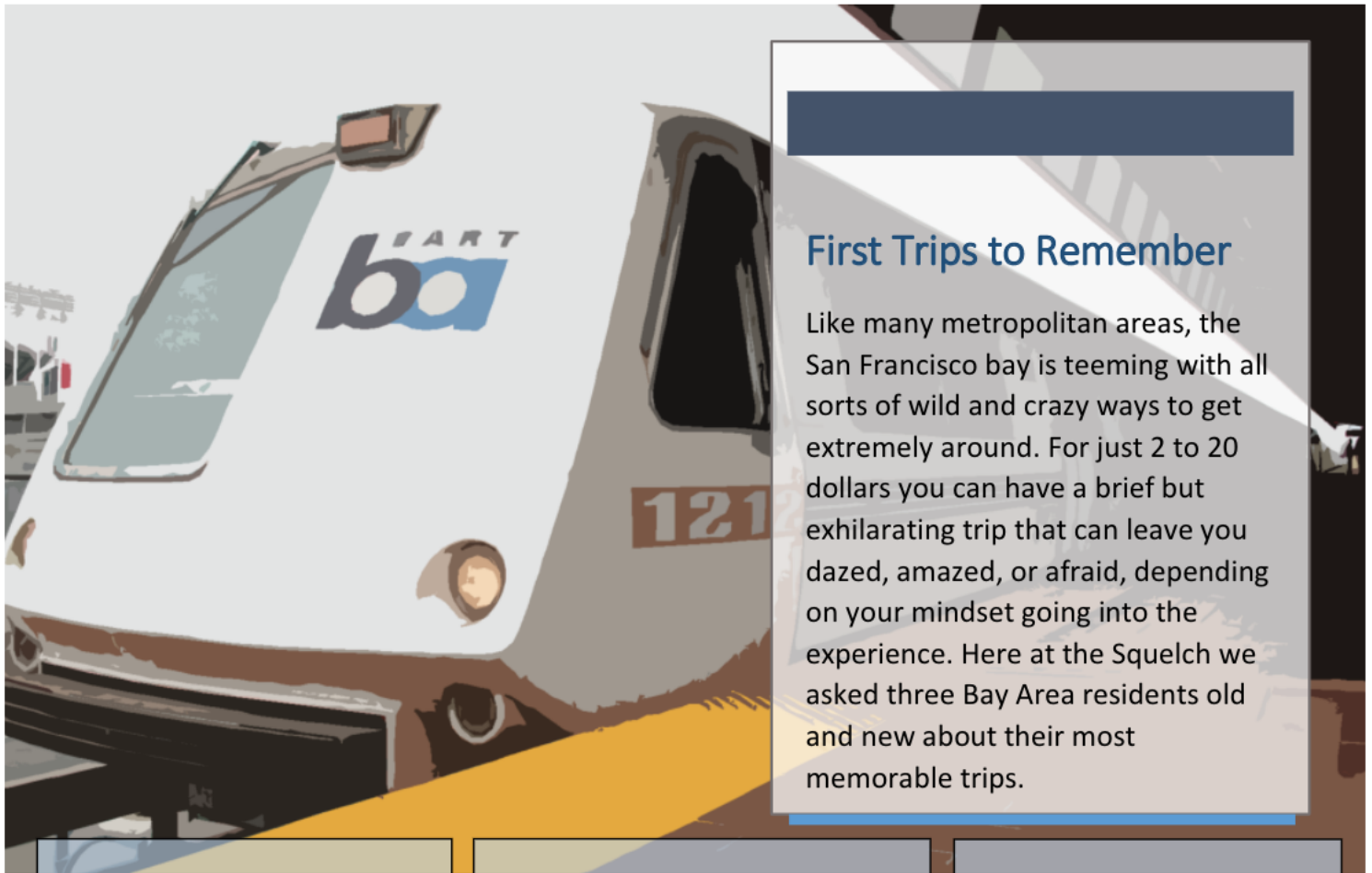
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First Trips to Remember

Like many metropolitan areas, the San Francisco bay is teeming with all sorts of wild and crazy ways to get extremely around. Here at the Squelch we asked three Bay Area residents old and new about their most memorable trips.

Everett, 44

A play on their famous sandwich - the juicy tri-tip is covered in melted Kinder eggs, toy and all.

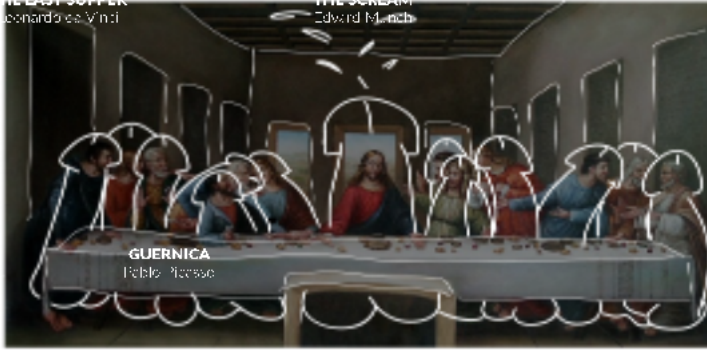
Beluga caviar at Chez Panisse \$200.00
